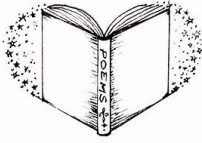

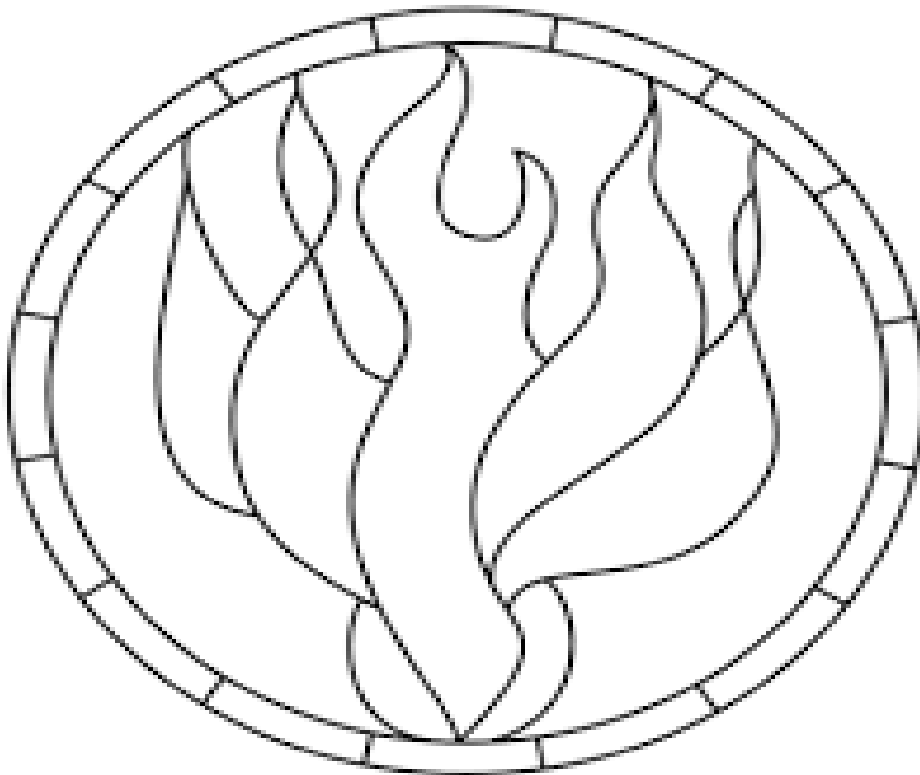
Most people will have noticed that the workmen are busy repairing the **drains**. This may cause some inconvenience but is absolutely essential. Please take care when in the area of the works.
